Every person seeking benefits under the Uniform Act must certify as to residency status. Any person who is an alien not lawfully present in the United States is ineligible for relocation advisory services and relocation payments, unless such ineligibility would result in exceptional and extremely unusual hardship to a qualifying spouse, parent, or child. Certificate of Legal Residency in the United States
