Q1	<p>Question: required testing experience</p> <p>The RFP states that without a college degree or a NICET Level II Certification, the tester shall have 5 years of testing experience with CDOT construction projects.</p> <p>Will CDOT hold the line on that requirement, or will there be some flexibility with the years of experience?</p> <p>If a firm has a head tester with over 5 years of CDOT experience that oversees the project testing technicians, will that qualify for the experience requirements?</p> <p>Does testing for a municipality or residential qualify as experience?</p> <p>Answer: 1) Will CDOT hold the line on [the 5 years of testing experience] requirement, or will there be some flexibility with the years of experience?</p> <p>It is CDOT's desire to have testers that meet the requirements stated in the RFP/SOW. That being said, failing to meet the amount of experience listed in the RFP would not disqualify the team's proposal, but that failure may/will be reflected in the panelists' scores for that section.</p> <p>2) If a firm has a head tester with over 5 years of CDOT experience that oversees the project testing technicians, will that qualify for the experience requirements?</p> <p>If the head tester is testing on the project, then yes it meets the requirements. But, another's (head tester) experience does not count for someone else's (the tester) experience.</p> <p>3) Does testing for a municipality or residential qualify as experience?</p> <p>Testing for a municipality or residential counts as experience, but not towards the requirement of 5 years of testing experience with CDOT projects.</p>	01/17/2024
