Wastewater & water treatment facilities. Worked on directly or responsible for managing over 30 major projects totaling over \$1 billion.</p>
<p>2. Describe your experience with construction claims:</p> <p>Involved with 4 major claims as testifying witness both state and federal courts as contractor representative. During last 19 years as expert witness have prepared / defended over 200 claims for contractors, owners, and subcontractors. Testified in over 30 depositions and trials. As neutral arbitrator, mediator, and DRB member have issued opinions for over 200 issues. Above claims/disputes ranged from \$5K to over \$30 million.</p>
<p>3. Describe your knowledge of construction contract law:</p>

During last 19 years became familiar with federal and various states law regarding construction disputes as described above. Drafted and conducted training seminars for Lorman Education Seminar and other associations which included construction law.

4. Describe your experience with construction contract administration:

Entire career have utilized contract administrative systems both as owner representative and contractor. These include scheduling, financial, change orders, submittals and other related engineering processes. Directly managed construction projects and staff as project manager and as VP & senior VP responsible for procurement and management of multi projects for over 10 years, with annual volumes ranging from \$50 million to \$300 million per year. As consultant and DRB member on over 250 projects became familiar with all types of various administrative systems. Conducted training classes, including contract administration, for Lorman Education Seminars and other organizations.

5. Describe your construction field experience:

With Cal Trans as field inspector for earthwork, minor structures, grading and paving. As project engineer, superintendent and project manager for contractors over 10 projects with value in excess of \$250 million. Was responsible for all planning, material procurement, special equipment design and management of field staff, direct labor and subcontractors. Varied projects: tunnel, pumping plants, bridges, power and marine facilities. As joint venture partner estimated, procured and directly managed 3 projects totaling over \$50 million. As surety companies representative took over and managed 5 failed contracts.

6. Describe your DRB (or arbitration) training, certification, and experience:

Certified AAA construction arbitrator since 1985 with annual training every year. As a single arbitrator or panel member, arbitrated over 20 cases with disputes up to \$10 mil. Have been on 50 dispute review board projects totaling over \$2.5 bill. in construction volume. Conducted over 150 DRB dispute hearings some in amounts up to \$8 mil. All were accepted or negotiated without further litigation. Project types included highways, bridges, universty buildings, airports and wastewater treatment facilities. Founding member of the Dispute Resolution Board Foundation and active since inception as membership chairman, board of directors, Northwest representative and president-elect for 2011, Region 1 (US and Canada). For the past 5 years have prepared DRB training materials and provided training seminars throughout the US.

7. Describe your employment/retirement status and availability to serve on a DRB and geographical area:

I have downsized my consulting business during the last two years and now focus almost entirely on neutral work including mediation, arbitration and DRB's. Currently serve on 10 DRB projects located in California, Washington and Idaho. Geographical areas where I would be willing to serve on Boards would be anywhere in US or overseas.
