Grant Awards

There are two types of awards for FY 2025, infrastructure grants and non-infrastructure grants. Each of these have a separate funding maximum and minimum. In total, the CSRTS program has **approximately \$7M** to award to successful applicants.

Infrastructure (INF) Grants: The minimum grant award is \$100,000 and a maximum of \$1M of SRTS Funding per project

Non-Infrastructure (NIF) Grants: The minimum grant award is \$5000 and a maximum of \$1M of SRTS Funding per Project.

Match

- 100% Funding if eligible, p. 10; Assessed on backend of application
- Equation:
 - **Requested amount:** \$500,000
 - Let's say your requested amount is \$500,000, as above. To find match, we will divide your requested amount (\$500,000, in this example) by .80 (80%) to yield the total project cost of \$625,000. We will then multiply that new amount, \$625,000, by .20 (20%), yielding
 - **Match amount:** \$125,000

- Note - If eligible for 100% Match, total project funding will not exceed \$1M
