Subject: Statewide Transportation Planning and CDOT 10-Year Plan Overview

Purpose

This memorandum provides the Board of Directors with a broad overview of multimodal transportation planning in Colorado, as well as the CDOT 10-Year Transportation Plan.

Action

No action is required. This agenda topic is for informational and discussion purposes only.

Background

CDOT conducts long-range multimodal planning activities and outreach to identify what Coloradans need from their transportation system over a 20-year planning horizon. CDOT adopted the 2045 Statewide Transportation Plan in August 2020 which identified safety, mobility, and asset management as the key overarching themes of the plan. Other key planning documents that are integrated with the long-range transportation plan include the statewide transit plan, the regional transportation plans and transit plans, the 10-Year Plan, and the 4-Year Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

Next Steps

CDOT Staff is happy to answer any questions and provide additional information regarding this topic to the Board of Directors if requested. The current planning process is underway with consultations with regional partners. Staff anticipates adoption of the next 10-Year Plan to occur in winter of 2025-26.
