

**Resolution – HPTE #102**

**Approving the Adjustment of Morning Peak Period Toll Rates for I-25 Express Lanes, effective July 1, 2013**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to C.R.S. 43-4-806, the General Assembly created the Colorado High Performance Transportation Enterprise (HPTE) as a government-owned business within the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT); and

**WHEREAS** HPTE entered into an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) dated 8/30/2011 with the Regional Transportation District (RTD) which provides that the I-25 HOV/tolled Express Lanes peak period toll cannot be any less than the express bus fare for that route; and

**WHEREAS** the IGA defines the morning peak period to be 6:45 a.m. – 8:45 a.m.;

**WHEREAS** a toll adjustment is required for the first hour of the morning peak period so that tolls align with, and are in compliance with the IGA; and

**WHEREAS** HPTE desires to adjust toll rates for the first hour (6:45 a.m. – 7:45 a.m.) of the morning peak period on the I-25 HOV/tolled Express Lanes between downtown Denver and US 36 so that the new toll rates will be \$4.00 for ExpressToll customers for the full morning peak period.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** the High Performance Transportation Enterprise Board hereby approves adjusting toll rates for the first hour of the morning peak period (6:45 a.m. – 7:45 a.m.) on the I-25 HOV/tolled Express Lanes between downtown Denver and US 36 so that the new toll rates will be \$4.00 for ExpressToll customers for the full morning peak period (6:45 a.m. – 8:45 a.m.), effective July 1, 2013. All other toll rates shall remain the same for now.
