ST	TBD	EVCRAA Program Funds	DIS	\$8,300,000				The Electric Vehicle Charger Reliability & Accessibility Accelerator (EVCRAA) Program is a new federal program under the umbrella of the broader Infrastructure Investment & Jobs Act (IIJA) of 2021. Program funds may be used for the repair or replacement of existing but non-functional public EV chargers across the United States, with eligibility limited to those specific sites identified in a national list issued by the FHWA in October 2023. In December 2023, CDOT's Office of Innovative Mobility (OIM) submitted a competitive application for enough funding to address every Colorado-based site on the national list, and in February 2024 we received notice that CDOT was awarded \$8.3 million in EVCRAA funds to complete repair or replacement projects at approximately 197 separate locations across the state. The intention is for the implementation of this project to be managed centrally at CDOT HQ by OIM staff with support from one or more EV charging installation contractors.
