Traffic Impacts - Week of June 25

Full Overnight Closure of Northbound and Southbound I-25 for Colorado Avenue Bridge Rehabilitation and Paving I-25

- Overnight closure of northbound I-25 between Nevada Avenue/Tejon Street and Bijou Street, including the northbound I-25 on and off-ramps, to prepare for Colorado Avenue Bridge rehabilitation work and paving on northbound I-25.
 - Sunday, June 25, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Closure between Nevada Avenue/Tejon Street and Cimarron Street/US 24.
 - Monday, June 26, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Closure between Nevada Avenue/Tejon Street and Bijou Street.
 - Southbound left lane closure on I-25 between Bijou Street and Cimarron Street/US 24.

- Overnight closure of southbound I-25 between Bijou Street and Nevada Avenue/Tejon Street, including the southbound I-25 on and off-ramps, to prepare for Colorado Avenue Bridge rehabilitation work and paving on southbound I-25.
 - Tuesday, June 27, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Northbound left lane closure on I-25 between Cimarron Street/US 24 to Bijou Street.
 - Wednesday, June 28 and Thursday, June 29, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly.

- Three through lanes on I-25 in each direction in the vicinity of the I-25 bridge over Colorado Avenue will remain open, but the continuous auxiliary lanes onto northbound I-25 from Cimarron Street to the Bijou Street exit, and onto southbound I-25 from Bijou Street to the Cimarron Street/US 24 exit will be changed to merge lanes with short merge distances to accommodate room for crews to work.
- The posted speed limit will reduce to 45 miles per hour on northbound and southbound I-25 between Bijou Street and Cimarron Street/US 24.

Overnight Lane Restrictions

Various Daytime Lane Restrictions

Drivers are Urged to Slow Down and Pay Attention

- Speed reduction to 55 mph on I-25 between South Nevada Avenue/Tejon Street and Cimarron/US24 (northbound and southbound)

- Speed reduction to 45 mph on I-25 from Cimarron/US24 to Bijou Street (northbound and southbound)
- Speed reduction to 30 mph on US 24/Cimarron Street between 8th Street and I-25 (westbound and eastbound)
- Pay close attention when driving near the I-25/Cimarron Project.
- Slow down, observe speed limits, avoid distractions, and allow extra time for your commute.
- Alternative route advised.
