



I-70 Silverthorne to Frisco Repaving Project

Project Overview

The Colorado Department of Transportation and prime contractor, United Companies, will begin construction on westbound lanes from Silverthorne to Frisco along I-70 starting the first week of May. Work is expected to go through late fall.

The project will span for approximately five miles from MM 203 to MM 207. Work will include the following items:

- Repaving all westbound lanes in the construction zone
- Removal and replacement of deteriorating portions of concrete bridge decks, which will improve the bridge's integrity and longevity
- Upgrades to existing guardrail; new features will help prevent future slope erosion

Traffic Impacts

The construction team understands I-70 is vital to local commuters and the economic health of Summit County. Minimizing impacts to visitors and residents has been considered.

Therefore, work will take place from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., starting on Monday nights and ending Friday mornings. Weekend work is not anticipated although schedules are subject to change. While work is underway, only one westbound lane will remain open for motorists. Bridge deck work may require additional closures.
