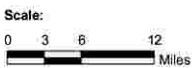

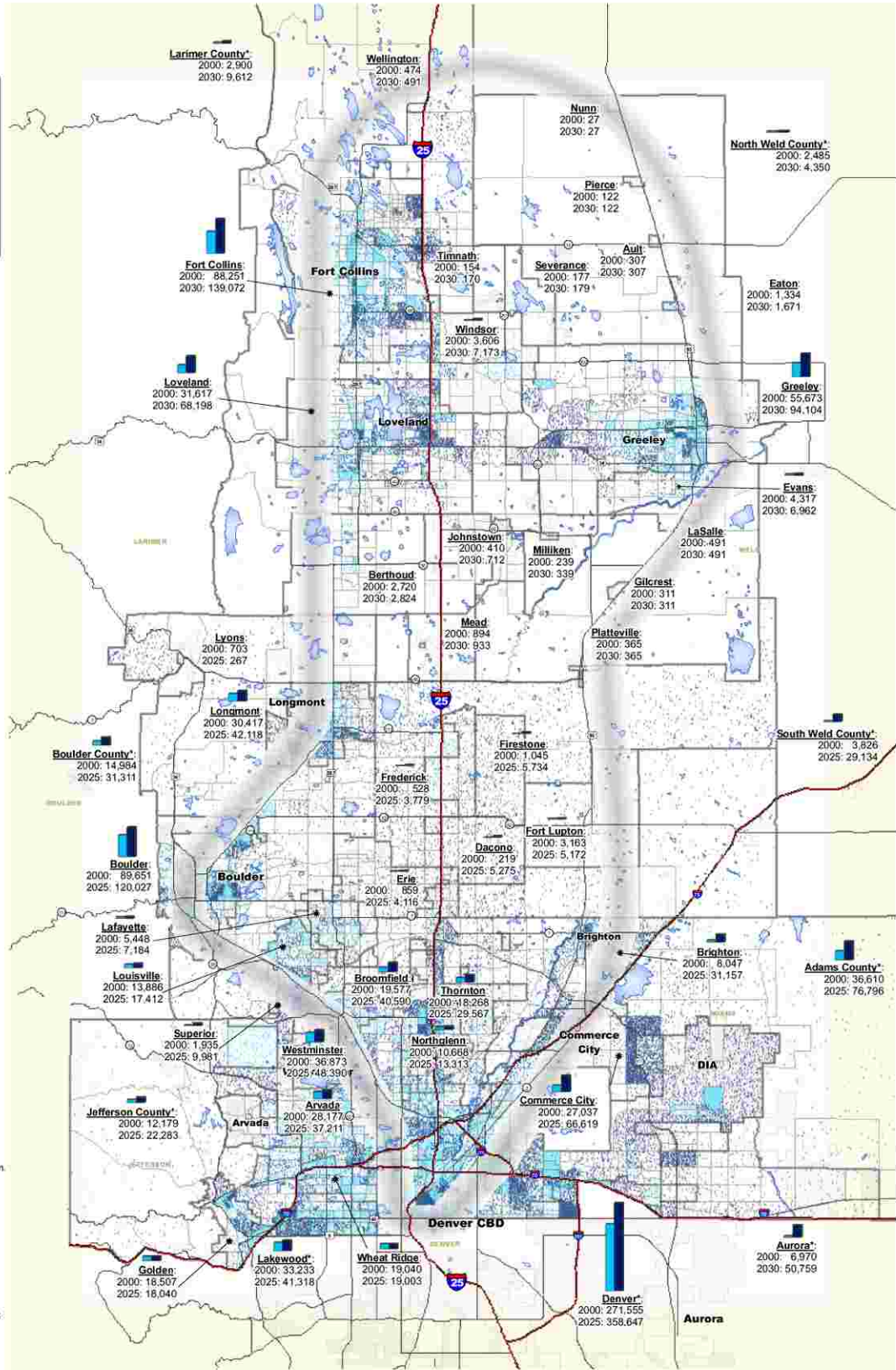


Future Employment Growth Summarized by Municipal Area

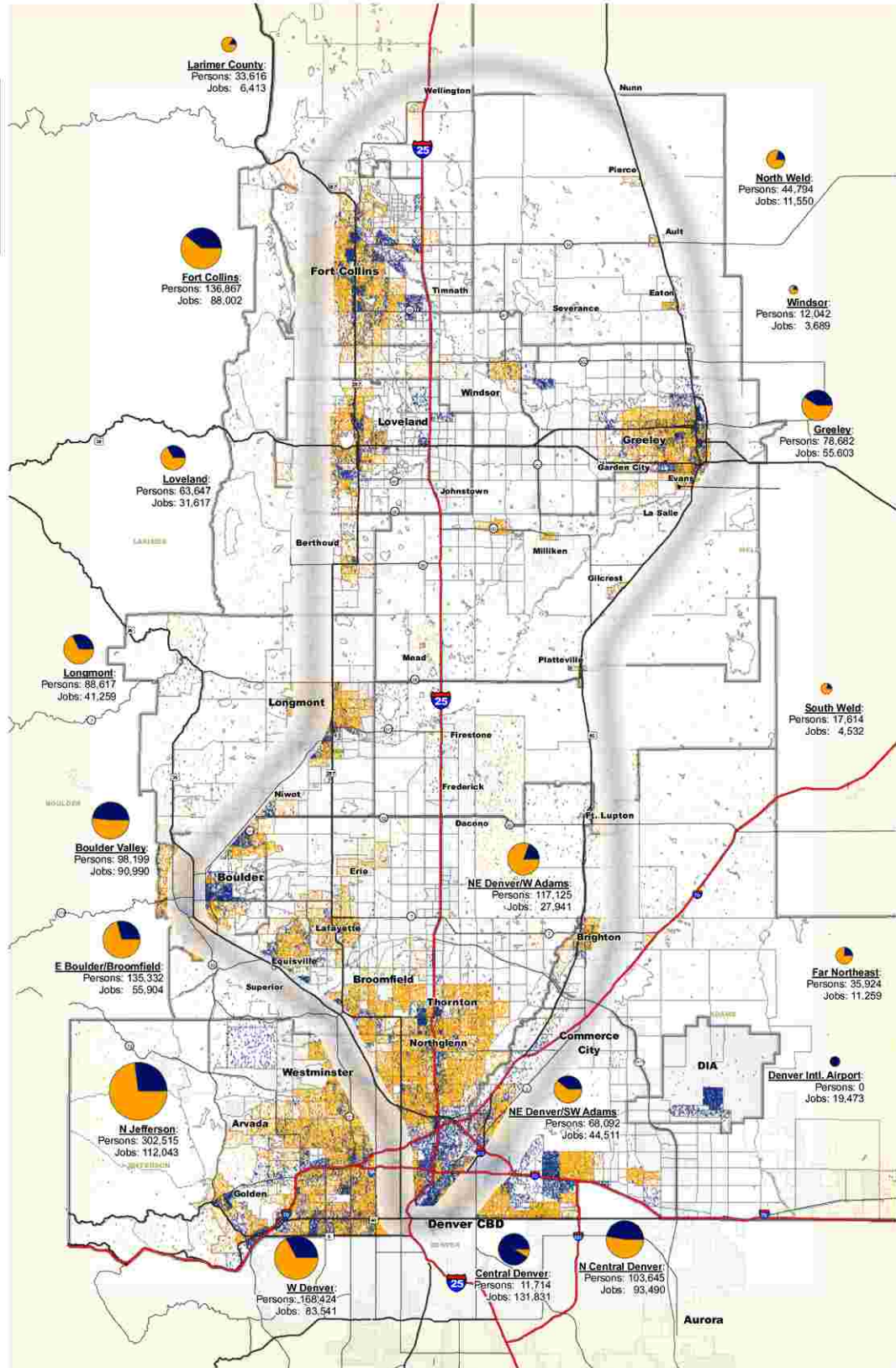


2000 Distribution of Population and Jobs Summarized by Sub-Regions

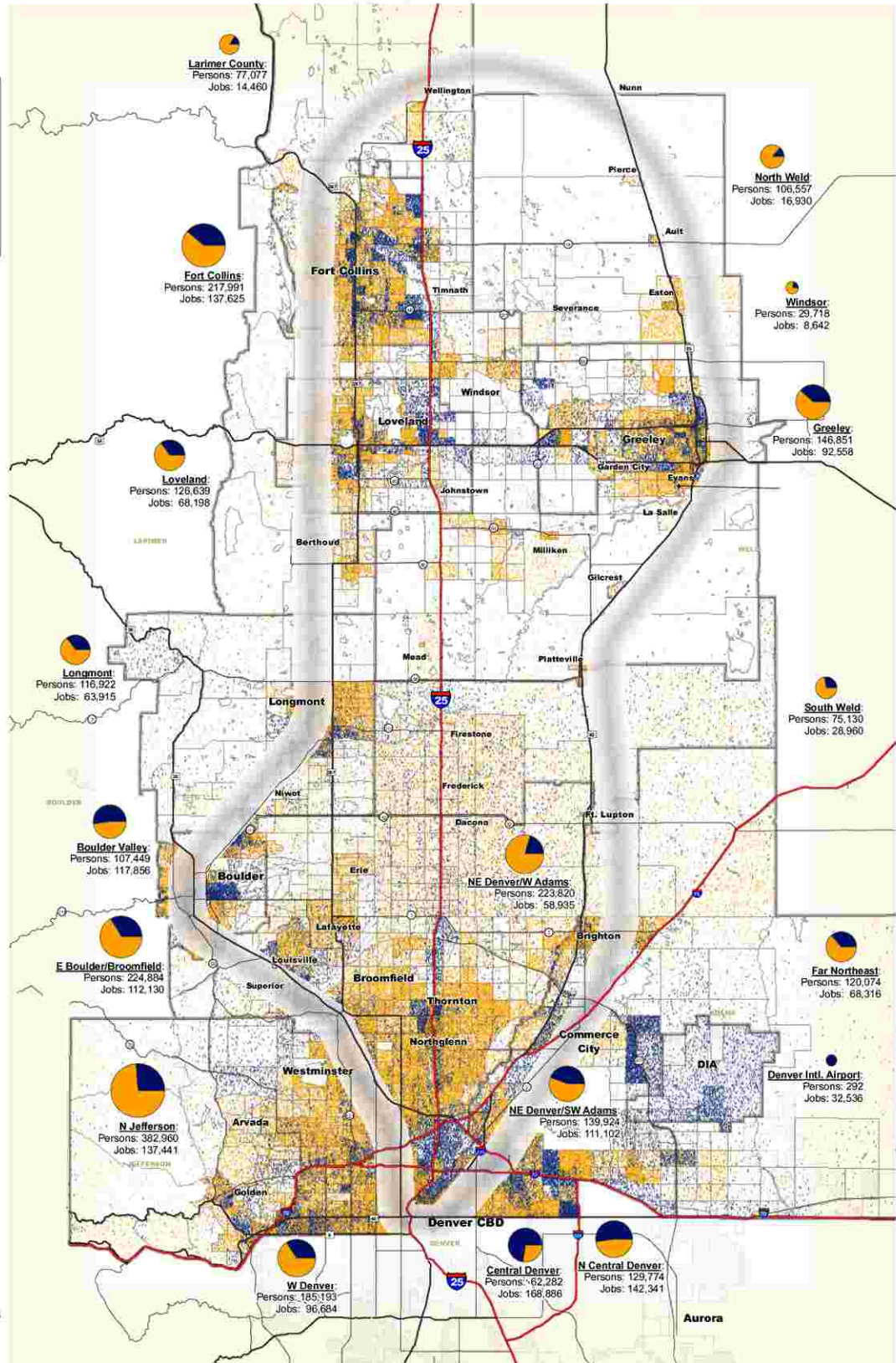


Projected Future Population and Jobs Summarized by Sub-Regions

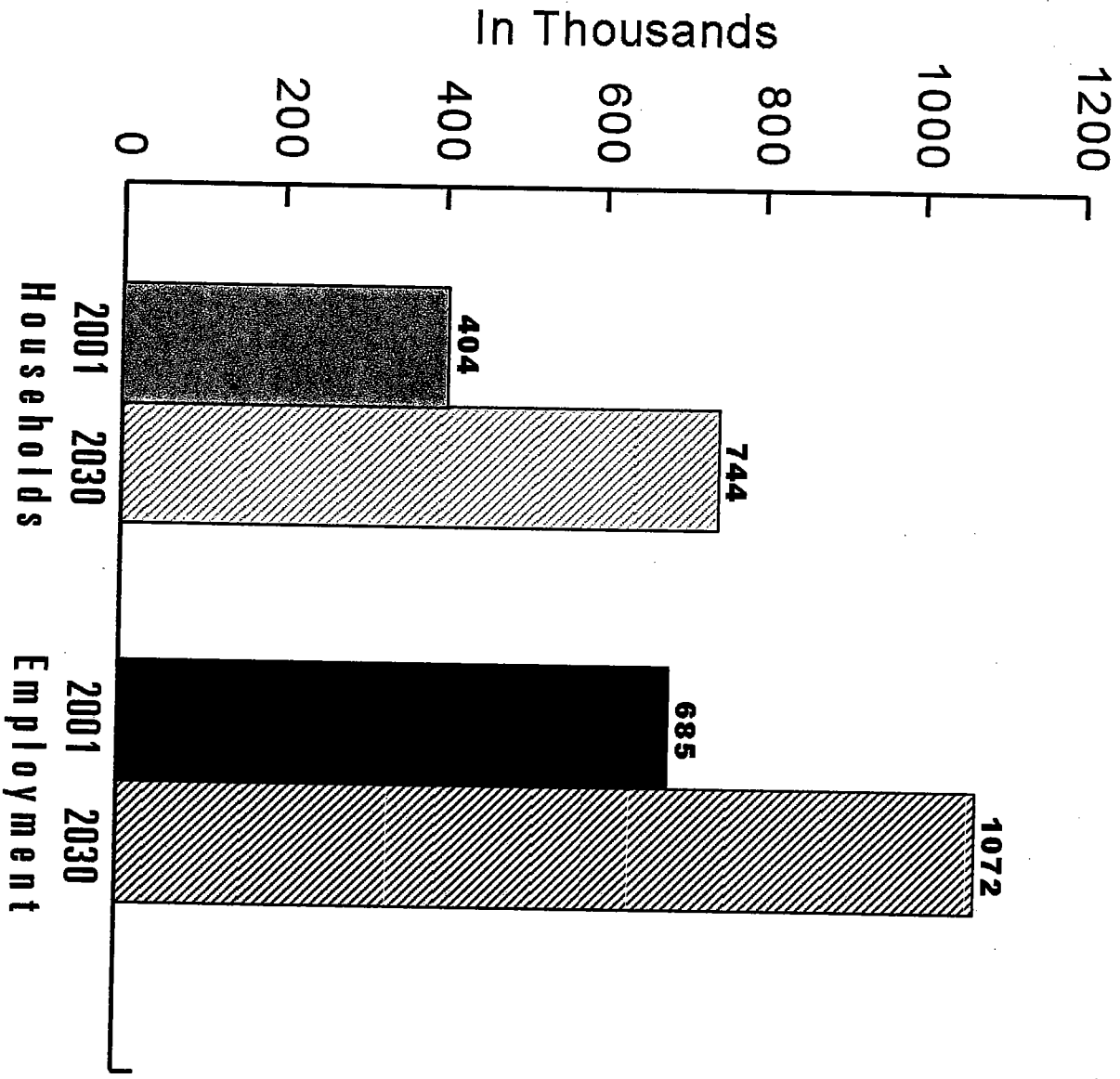

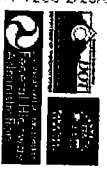

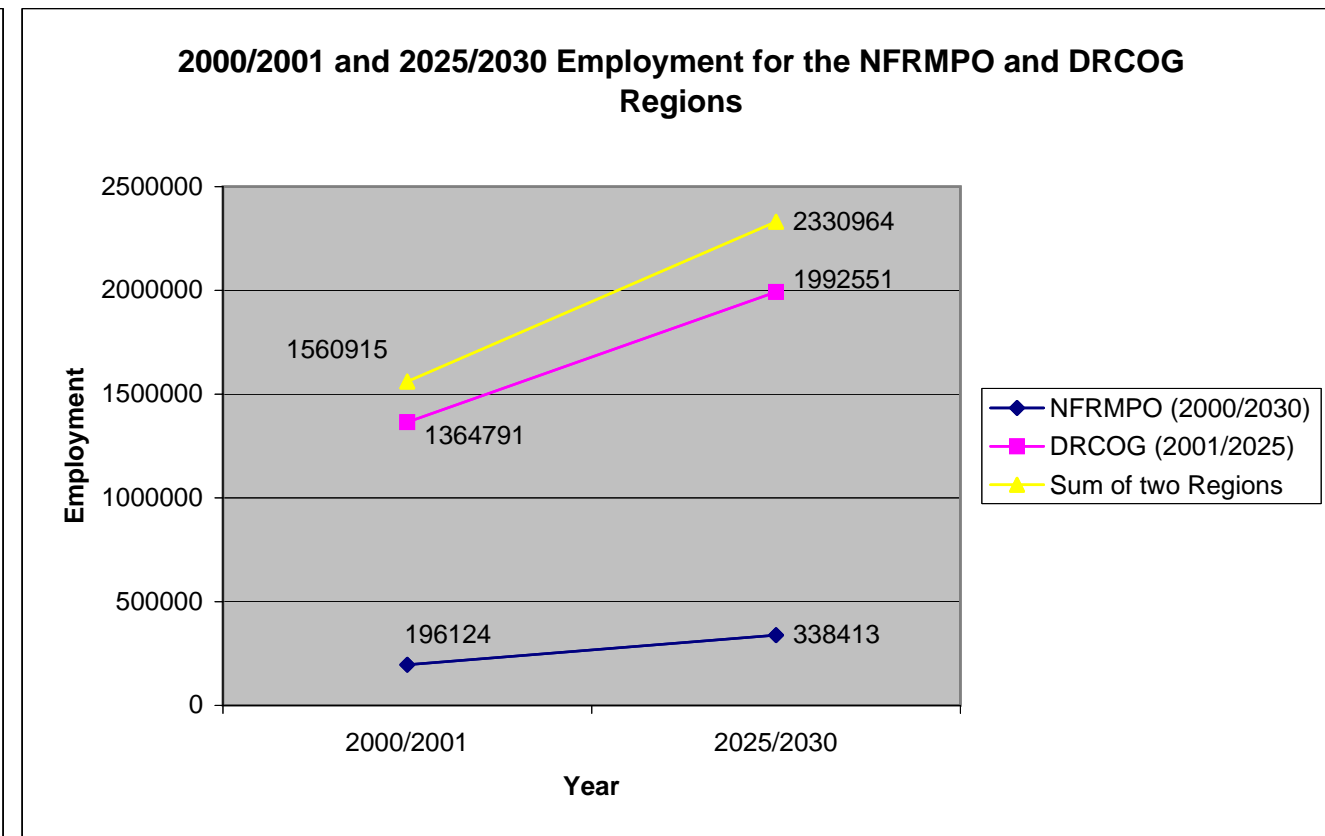
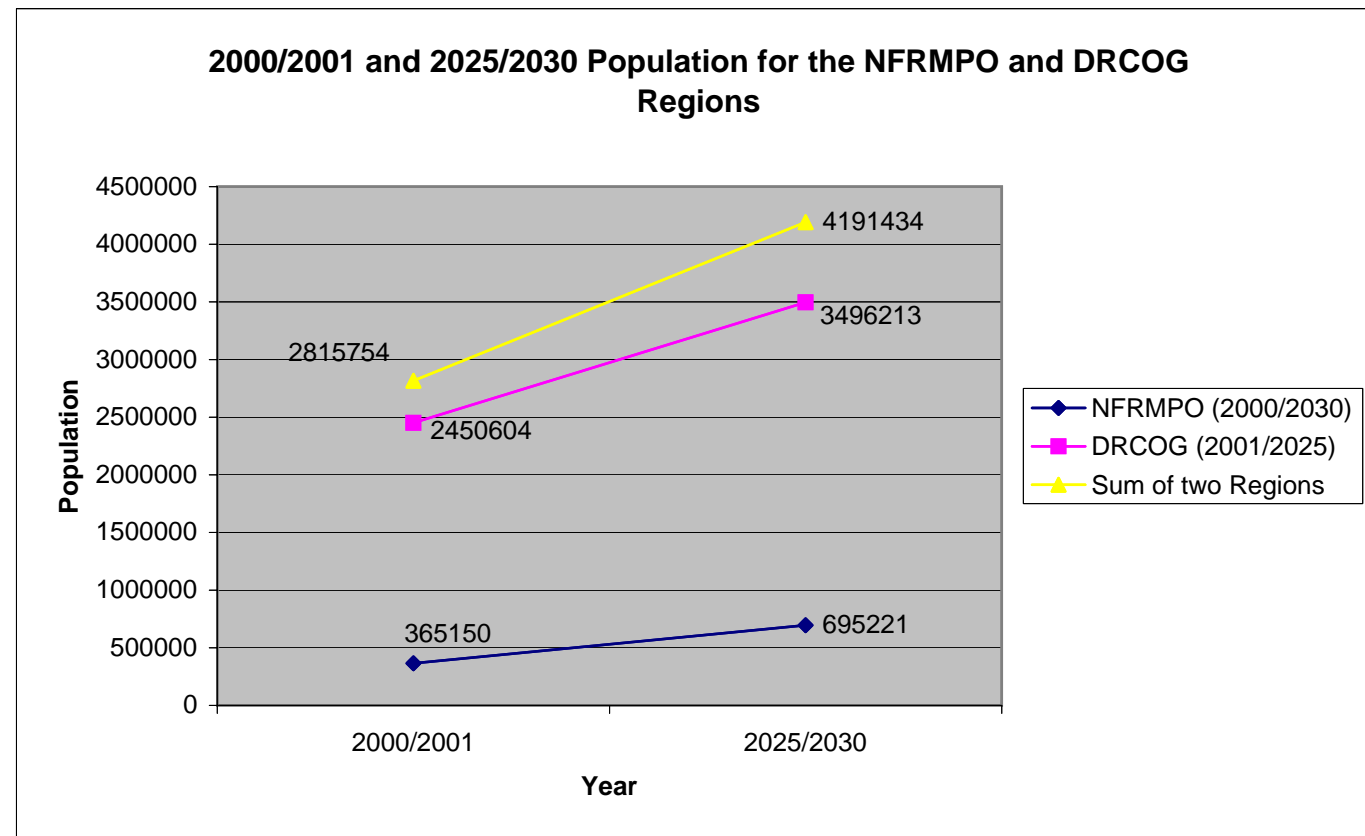
