Northbound College Avenue work set to move north of Laurel Street in July

Last section of major road reconstruction starts soon

Starting in early to mid-July, northbound College Avenue will be reduced to one through lane between Laurel Street and Mulberry Street for approximately six weeks. College Avenue will remain open. However, lane closures will be in place 24 hours, seven days a week, until the work is complete. Crews will place a barrier wall along northbound College Avenue to create a temporary work zone along the east side of the road. On-street parking will be prohibited during this work. Myrtle Street east of College Avenue will be closed to through traffic. All business driveways on Myrtle Street and alley access will remain open.

Crews are currently performing similar work between Garfield Street and Laurel Street. Work south of Laurel Street will be finished prior to moving north. Full-depth roadway reconstruction involves removing buried concrete panels that have been covered by multiple asphalt overlays. New curb and gutter are part of the project.

All work is weather-dependent and the schedule is subject to change. Normal work hours are 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Some night and weekend work is possible. A width restriction of 11 feet is necessary. Pedestrian access will be maintained through work zones and to businesses within the affected area.

Night resurfacing work proceeds north throughout the summer

Crews will soon begin resurfacing work between Foothills Parkway and Drake Road. Work south of Horsetooth Road is nearing completion. Crews will continue to perform work overnight in order to minimize daytime traffic impacts. Motorists should expect delays associated with single and double lane closures from 8pm - 6am. College Avenue will remain open to through traffic during the work.

As necessary, traffic control personnel will assist traffic through major intersections. Affected driveways and cross streets will be closed intermittently when asphalt milling equipment passes through. Signed detour routes will be provided for traffic turning on and off of College Avenue during overnight asphalt placement. It will take approximately three weeks to complete paving in both directions between Foothills Parkway and Drake Road. Crews will proceed north along College Avenue throughout the summer. At times, motorists will be driving on milled or temporary surfaces. Some equipment noise is expected overnight.
