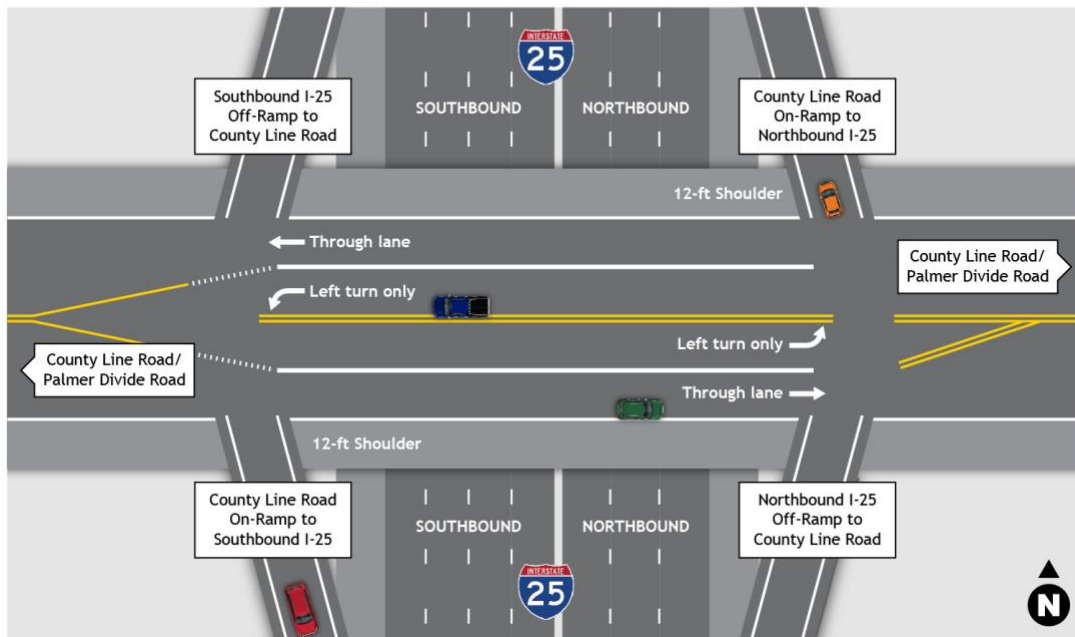




County Line Road Bridge Reconstruction

In spring 2021, the Colorado Department of Transportation and contractor partner Kraemer North America will begin reconstruction of the County Line Road bridge over I-25 in Monument. It is one of five bridges being replaced as part of the I-25 South Gap project. The County Line Road bridge will double in size to accommodate one through-lane and one turn-lane in each direction, and shoulders on each side.

RECONSTRUCTION PHASING

The bridge will be built in two separate phases. First, crews will build the outside lanes of the bridge. Once those lanes are built, they will demolish the existing bridge structure and reconstruct the bridge to connect it to the new outside lanes.

Major reconstruction of the County Line Road bridge is expected to be complete by the end of 2021. Construction of the 18-mile I-25 South Gap project, including the surrounding County Line Road bridge area, remains on-time for completion in November 2022. All construction activities are weather-dependent and subject to change. Watch for narrower lane and shoulder widths, and always pay attention and follow posted speeds. BRIDGE RECONSTRUCTION IMPACTS

Improvements to the County Line Road bridge will fix sight distance issues on the ramps, upgrade aging infrastructure (built in 1964) and improve County Line ramp acceleration and deceleration lanes. Impacts for this work include:

- Increased flaggers and truck traffic on the County Line Road bridge
- Six-week closure of the northbound I-25 on- and off-ramps at County Line Road
- Four-day closure of the County Line Road bridge, intersections and ramps
- Periodic closures of County Line Road bridge and I-25, with ramp detours, for overhead bridge work and demolition

For most of construction, access across the County Line Road bridge will be maintained.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

CDOT is improving 18 miles of I-25 between Monument and Castle Rock by widening the highway from two to three lanes in each direction. The new lane will operate as an Express Lane, allowing motorists the choice of taking the Express Lane for a faster, more reliable travel time in exchange for a toll. Express Lanes will be free to vehicles with three or more people and motorcycles. All travelers will have the choice of taking the general-purpose lanes for free.

The \$419 million project also includes shoulder widening, rebuilding bridges, new wildlife crossings, resurfacing with new pavement, a southbound I-25 truck climbing lane from Greenland Road south, a southbound I-25 truck chain-up station near Larkspur and modernizing technology. Project completion is scheduled for November 2022.
