



# Year in Review 2020

## Milestones

- Feb. 29 Crews participate in procession for USS Arizona Survivor Don Stratton
- March 11 CDOT/State Patrol host media event related to air patrol and safety in the I-25 South Gap
- March 16 Crews completed girder sets on Spruce Mountain Road bridge
- March 19 Crews complete wall panels on Spruce Mountain Road bridge
- March 25 Crews complete drainage work that required long-term full closures of both the East and West Frontage Roads
- April 20 Grading begins for southbound climbing lane
- April 22 Crews install girders for wildlife crossing at MP 164.5
- April 27-30 Crews complete deck pour for Spruce Mountain Road Bridge
- April 29 Crews place girders for wildlife crossing at MP 170
- May 6 First half of new Greenland Road bridge is complete
- May 8 Crews place girders for bridge over Plum Creek
- May 11 Deck pour is completed on the southbound side of the wildlife crossing at MP 164
- May 27 Deck pour is completed on the northbound side of the wildlife crossing at MP 164
- June 5 Traffic along SB I-25 in the northern portion of the project is shifted into final alignment
- June 29 Deck pour is completed on first phase of Plum Creek bridge
- June 30 Greenland box is fully removed
- July 9 Traffic along NB I-25 in the northern portion of the project is shifted into final alignment
- Aug. 9 Southbound I-25 ramps at Greenland Road open into final alignment
- Aug. 11 Crews pour bridge deck on northbound side of the Wildlife Crossing at MP 170
- Aug. 20 Major traffic shifts south of County Line (SB) and near Upper Lake Gulch Road (NB) complete
- Aug. 21-23 Major drainage work under County Line Road bridge complete using 16-hour ramp surfs
- Aug. 24 Crews begin Monument Hill Frontage Road closure to accomplish wildlife crossing, soundwall and drainage construction
- Aug. 31 Major traffic shift complete near Spruce Mountain Road
- Aug. 31 Paving complete under Greenland Road underpass
- Sept. 12 Paving is complete in the northern section of the project
- Sept. 17 Crews remove all concrete construction barrier from the northern section of the project
- Sept. 23 Crews set girders on western portion of Greenland Road bridge
- Oct. 5 Southbound I-25 @ Plum Creek Parkway is back to its original configuration
- Oct. 6 Demolition of northbound Upper Lake Gulch Road bridge over I-25 complete
- Oct. 13 Northbound traffic shift in middle section, approaching Spruce Mountain Road, complete
- Oct. 14 Deck pour on the west side bridge at Greenland Road is complete
- Oct. 15 Crews set girders at the 162 wildlife crossing and removed all traffic control from northern portion of the project
- Oct 16 Sky View Lane/Tomah Road southbound on-ramp 14-day closure complete three days ahead of schedule
- Nov. 4 Phase two traffic shift complete on southbound I-25 between Sky View Lane/Tomah Road and Spruce Mountain Road
- Nov. 5 Crews place girders on wildlife crossing at MP 162, marking the final girders to be placed in all of the middle section
- Nov. 6 First roadway lighting illuminated
- Nov. 12 First completed bridge - Spruce Mountain Road - opens!
- Nov. 20 Deck pour at WLC 162 and Monument Hill Road is complete, marking the last deck pour in the middle section
- Dec. 10 Demolition of Plum Creek bridge complete
- Dec. 11 Sign bridges in the middle section completed
- Dec. 17 Crews place girders on Upper Lake Gulch Road bridge

Dec. 21 Greenland Road interchange complete
