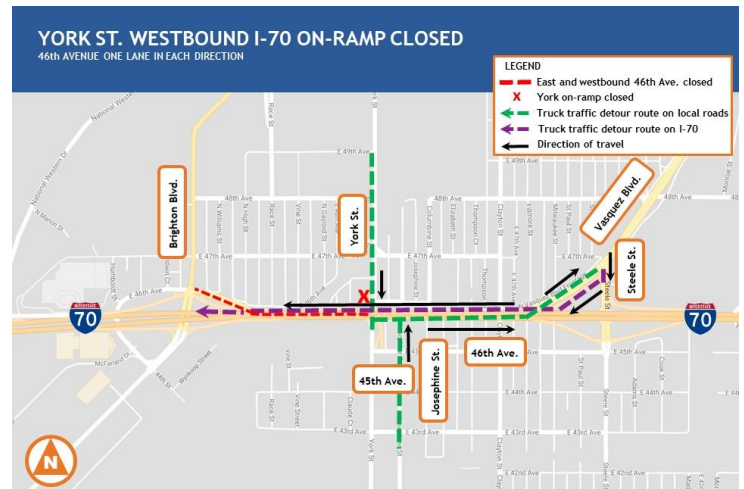
Closure of York Street On-Ramp and Changes to 46th Avenue

York Street on-ramp to westbound I-70 to close permanently

In preparation for constructing the new Union Pacific Railroad (UPRR) Bridge and the final design of I-70, crews will be implementing a permanent closure of the York Street on-ramp to westbound I-70, as soon as overnight Sunday night, Oct. 14 (see map 1). There will also be lane restrictions on York Street, south of 46th Avenue that will be in place for a couple of weeks. Later in October 46th Avenue will be reduced to one lane in each direction in the westbound lanes between York Street and Colorado Boulevard and the access to westbound I-70 will also change slightly (see map 2).
