



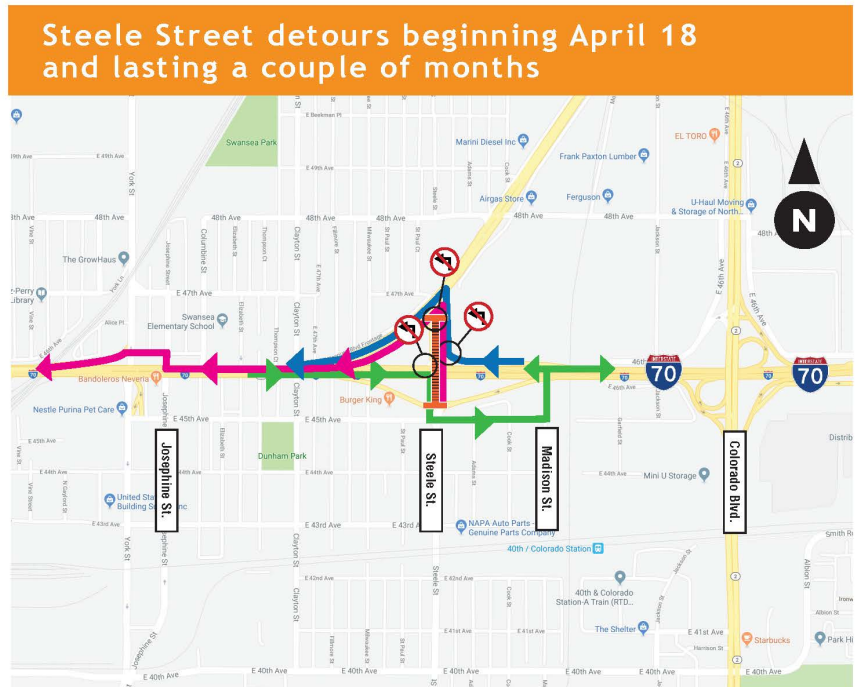
Steele Street Left Lane Closures





Third Party Utility Work to Begin April 23

Restrictions on Steele Street, between 45th and 47th avenues (under I-70), will be required starting Wednesday, April 23 and will last for at least a couple of months. Left-hand turns from both the on- and off-ramps from I-70 at Steele/Vasquez and northbound/southbound Steele Street may be restricted (see detour map on the right).

This work will be done in phases to minimize impacts to the traveling public, meaning all three left turns shown on the map will not be closed at the same time.

These closures are required to allow for third-party utility relocations, in preparation for construction on Central 70 beginning this summer.
