This announcement is to inform all Public and Private Flagger Certifying Entities, and Individuals who want to become Flaggers, that in 2015, the CDOT raised the passing score from 80% to 85% on exams one (1), two (2), and three (3).

The reason for this was to obtain a flagger who was duly qualified to perform traffic control functions. CDOT has been revising the flagger program to reflect a standard of care that will better protect flaggers and others from the inherent dangers of work zones.

The tests have not been updated to reflect this change due to many reasons, which will not be reflected in this announcement, however it is the said rule, that in order to pass the Flagger exams, a person does need to do so with an 85 % or better. This includes proctors and flaggers.
