


Colorado Traction Law Compliance

Survey Details

- 489 interviews and tire surveys
- Surveys conducted from February – April 2021
- 9 gas stations along I-70 between Gypsum and Evergreen
- Various locations, weather conditions and times

Vehicles Surveyed



Survey Takeaways

- 83% of all vehicles had 4WD or AWD
- 11% of all vehicles carried chains or traction device
- Nearly 75% of non-compliant vehicles were driven by Colorado residents
- 3% of surveyed vehicles were non-compliant rentals

During an active Traction Law, all motorists must have 3/16" tread depth and at least one of the following:

1. 4WD or AWD vehicle
2. Tires with a mud and snow designation (M+S icon)
3. Winter tires (mountain-snowflake icon)
4. Tire with an all-weather rating by the manufacturer
5. Chains or approved traction device
