


Colorado Traction Law Compliance

Survey Details

- 489 interviews and tire surveys
- Surveys conducted from February April 2021
- **9** gas stations along I-70 between Gypsum and Evergreen
- Various locations, weather conditions and times

Vehicles Surveyed




Survey Takeaways

- 83% of all vehicles had 4WD or AWD
- 11% of all vehicles carried chains or traction device
- Nearly 75% of non-compliant vehicles were driven by Colorado residents
- 3% of surveyed vehicles were non-compliant rentals

Traction Law Compliant Vehicles







During an active Traction Law, all motorists must have 3/16" tread depth and at least one of the following:

- 1. 4WD or AWD vehicle
- Tires with a mud and snow designation (M+S icon)
- 3. Winter tires (mountain-snowflake icon)
- 4. Tire with an all-weather rating by the manufacturer
- 5. Chains or approved traction device
